Eligibility to enter chain of custody:	All licenced lobster fishing vessels that can land lobster from the four UoCs listed here sell to a company that is a member of the Client Group (or to a local buyer who in turn sells to a member company) in order for that lobster to be eligible to enter Chain of Custody and to be eligible to carry the MSC logo. Processor members of the Client Group who process lobsters from the certified LFAs will require CoC Certification if they require these products to carry the MSC logo. Companies that ship live lobster outside of the membership of the Client Group require CoC Certification if they require the lobster to carry the MSC logo.
